

MINUTES - BUDGET SESSION**January 21, 1993**

The Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Warren met in special session at its office in the Administration Building, Belvidere, NJ on Thursday, January 21, 1993 at 6:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Director Kenneth Miller and upon roll call the following members were present: Mr. Matthenius, Mrs. Dickey and Mr. Miller.

Director Miller read the following statement: ADEQUATE NOTICE OF THIS MEETING WAS GIVEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT BY FORWARDING A SCHEDULE OF SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS TO THE WARREN COUNTY CLERK, THE STAR GAZETTE, THE BLAIRSTOWN PRESS, THE NEWS, THE STAR-LEDGER AND THE EXPRESS-TIMES AND BY POSTING A COPY THEREOF ON THE BULLETIN BOARD IN THE OFFICE OF THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS. FORMAL ACTION MAY BE TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS AT THIS MEETING. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IS ENCOURAGED.

The budgets of the Correctional Center and Juvenile Detention were discussed first. They were both approved as recommended.

There was a late request for one personnel change for the Correctional Center and Warden McGhee came in and explained the situation and the Board agreed to add a Head Nurse title to his department.

Under Health, the Division of Public Health was discussed and this budget was accepted as recommended. The Environmental Health Division was discussed and an additional request for Lyme Disease Education was brought up. The board members thought it was worthwhile and decided on \$2,000 for initial pamphlets and other educational materials to be purchased.

Under Human Services, the board discussed the Office for the Disabled, Aging and Nutrition and all three departments were accepted as recommended.

The rest of the Human Services Division will be heard on February 1, 1993.

On motion by Mr. Matthenius, seconded by Mrs. Dickey, the meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
