

SPECIAL SESSION WITH HUNTERDON COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS

The Boards of Chosen Freeholders of the Counties of Warren and Hunterdon met in Special Session at the Main Street County Complex, Freeholders' Meeting Room, 2nd Floor, 71 Main Street, Flemington, New Jersey 08822 on November 28, 2006.

Mr. Chamberlain called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Upon roll call, the following members were present: Freeholder Everett Chamberlain, Freeholder John DiMaio and Freeholder Richard Gardner. Also attending was County Administrator Steve Marvin and Special Counsel Stephen Shaw.

FORMAL ACTION MAY BE TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS AT THIS MEETING. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IS ENCOURAGED. IN ORDER TO ASSURE FULL PUBLIC PARTICIPATION, THOSE INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES WHO WISH TO ATTEND THE MEETING SHOULD SUBMIT ANY REQUESTS FOR SPECIAL ACCOMMODATION ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE.”**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTIVE SESSION OF THE WARREN COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS PROVIDING FOR A MEETING NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW JERSEY OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12

WHEREAS, the Warren County and Hunterdon County Boards of Chosen Freeholders are subject to certain requirements of the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, et seq.*, and

WHEREAS, the *Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12*, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Warren County and Hunterdon County Boards of Chosen Freeholders to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b(7) and designated below:

Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Warren County Board of Chosen Freeholders, assembled in public session on November 28, 2006, that an Executive Session closed to the Public shall be held on November 28, 2006, at 5:32 p.m. in the Main Street County Complex, Freeholders' Meeting Room, 2nd Floor, 71 Main Street, Flemington, NJ 08822 for the discussion of matters relating to the specific items designated above.
