**DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES**

The Warren County Division of Aging & Disability Services is authorized by the NJ Department of Human Services, Division of Aging Services and the Warren County Board of Chosen Freeholders as the lead agency in Warren County to provide, develop, and coordinate programs and services available to county residents aged 60 and older and/or residents age 18 and older with a physical disability.

The Division aims to assist Warren County residents in preserving their highest level of health, independence, and dignity by having easy access to information on the programs and services needed to make informed choices and decisions about their lives, their care, and their future. The Division also provides assistance in applying for and enrolling in programs and services to facilitate maximum independence.

The Warren County Division of Aging & Disability Services is also the provider of Adult Protective Services (APS) program. New Jersey APS law provides for the protection of a “vulnerable adult” from the willful infliction of “abuse, neglect, and/or exploitation”.
