**DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES**

In 1986, the New Jersey Division of Criminal Justice established the 21 county offices of victim-witness advocacy.

The goal of victim-witness advocacy is to provide victims and witnesses with support and services that will help with the aftermath of a crime.

Victim-witness advocates respond to a diversity of needs that begin immediately following the crime and continue through the court process.

These services include:

- Crisis intervention and emergency services
- Transportation
- Referral to social service agencies
- Criminal justice orientation
- Court accompaniment
- Case status information
- Childcare
- Private waiting areas
- Information about Victims of Crime Compensation
- Restitution
- Return of Property

There are specialized victim advocates within the prosecutor's office committed to seeing that victims and witnesses are treated with dignity and respect.
