DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

CPRWC provides referrals for alcoholism, tobacco, substance addiction and related issues and behavioral problems. Programs include: BABES, Forest Friends, Life Skills, Keys to InnerVision, Footprints, Positive Parenting and the Strengthening Families Program. Prevention Presentations include: Drug-specific presentations (i.e. alcohol, club drugs, prescription drugs, heroin), signs and symptoms of drug abuse, drug trends, tobacco education, Fatal Vision Goggles, Consequences of Underage Drinking, behavior modification, classroom management, Asset Building and CPS/CADC course work. CPRWC is designated as the County Resource Center and library supplying material on topics such as substance abuse and related issues, health and wellness, and community services. CPRWC participates in three coalitions: Community Action Partnership (CAP), Community Health Improvement Coalition (CHIC), Cancer Education Early Detection Coalition (CEED) while sitting on various committees and advisory boards dedicated to improving the quality of health for individuals and families of Warren County.
