Community Trials Intervention to Reduce Binge Drinking Among College Students (CTI)  
Community Trials Intervention is a long-term program to reduce high-risk drinking behaviors and alcohol abuse among Warren County Community College and Centenary College students.

LifeSkills Training I - An evidence-based primary prevention program focused on reducing substance abuse among Warren County youth attending grades six through eight at Lopatcong, Pohatcong, Alpha and Greenwich School Districts.

Regional Coalition for Health and Safe Communities - The mission of this two-county coalition is to create healthy and safe communities that are free from substance abuse, addiction and related issues among people of all ages throughout Warren and Sussex Counties. This coalition is in partnership with Sussex County Center for Prevention and Counseling.
