Description of Services

Crisis Screening Unit/24-hour Crisis Hotline: Available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week to provide immediate response to Warren County residents experiencing a mental health crisis via the 24-hour Crisis Hotline and round-the-clock mobile outreach. The Crisis Screening Unit works with individuals, families and systems to offer assessment and early intervention during a mental health crisis to stabilize crisis situations and to facilitate voluntary and involuntary hospitalizations if needed.

Family Crisis Intervention Unit (FCIU): The FCIU provides Immediate assistance to families experiencing serious disruption in child/parent relationships (i.e. truancy, runaway behavior, family conflict) to avoid involvement in the juvenile justice system and to keep families together. Crisis intervention services are available to Warren County families 24 hours/day, 7 days per week in a variety of community locations (e.g. schools, homes, local emergency departments) in addition to our offices.

Involuntary Outpatient Commitment (IOC): This is a community-based treatment program for adults (18years old or older) who are Court-ordered into the program as a result of mental illness, who are unwilling to receive services voluntarily and are likely to become a danger to themselves, others or property in the foreseeable future. Services provided include: case management; care coordination; individual, group and family counseling; medication management and participation in treatment and wellness planning.

Traumatic Loss Coalition of Warren County (TLC): TLC at the Family Guidance Center is part of a statewide network that offers collaboration and support to professionals working with school-age youth when a traumatic loss has occurred. The dual mission of the TLC is to provide: Excellence in suicide prevention and Trauma Response Assistance to schools following losses due to suicide, homicide, accident and illness.
