**DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES**

Hope House a division of Catholic Family and Community Services is located in Dover, New Jersey serving clients from Morris, Sussex and Warren counties. We provide a continuum of outpatient behavioral health services that includes a continuum of substance abuse treatment and outpatient mental health counseling for the Spanish speaking population. We also provide an array of community based social services including case management, housing assistance, counseling and transportation for individuals affected by HIV/AIDS. The Community Support Services Program at Hope House provides comprehensive HIV/AIDS specific psychosocial support services in northwest New Jersey. Hope House also has a food pantry and a Latino Women's Drop In Center.

Our Senior/Home Services programs primary purpose is to help prevent the premature institutionalization of senior citizens and younger disabled individuals in Morris County. Our Chore Program provides weekly or bi-weekly (depending on the client's individual needs) household maintenance, consistent food shopping and laundry service, to insure a sanitary and healthy home environment. In addition, all Chore Attendants are trained to perform ongoing assessments, watching for failing health or safety concerns.

Our popular Hope Connection Program is an affordable personal emergency response system, aimed to assist seniors and individuals with disabilities to maintain security and independence in their homes.
