




**TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN  
ORDINANCE NO. 2010-13**

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF WARREN,  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
FRANKLIN AMENDING THE LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT CHAPTER  
TO REQUIRE MANDATORY SOLAR POWERED STREET LIGHTING FOR  
ALL NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN THE TOWNSHIP WHERE FEASIBLE**

**WHEREAS**, the Township has recognized the importance of the use of solar energy and the benefits of using such alternative energy on the environment;

**WHEREAS**, the availability and cost for the installation of solar streetlighting has been determined to be reasonable;

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. § 40:55D-1, et al, grants the Township the authority to regulate the installation of streetlighting with all new developments in the Township;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Warren, State of New Jersey as follows:

Streetlighting, which is at the discretion of the Land Use Board, for all development in the Township, including all subdivisions and site plans, must be powered by solar energy, except where the Township Engineer determines that the use of solar energy in the subject location is not feasible.

All other streetlighting standards contained within Chapter 90 – Land Use and Development shall continue to apply to the extent not inconsistent with this ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage, approval and publication according to law.

Date of final reading, November 1st, 2010.

Adoption of the within Ordinance 2010-13 held at a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010, at the hour of 7:00 p.m.

The within Ordinance 2010-13 was moved by Michael Toretta and seconded by Joe Flynn and upon roll call vote was passed.


