WHAT IS A POD?

A POD (Point of Dispensing) is a temporary clinic site where medication or vaccine can be given to large numbers of people in the event of a naturally occurring outbreak of disease or a bioterrorist attack.

During the TOPOFF 3 exercise each county in New Jersey is being asked to open a POD for the purpose of testing their ability to dispense medications to several hundred people in a short period of time.

In order to adequately test our POD Plan, we need at least 250 volunteers of all ages to play the role of victims.
